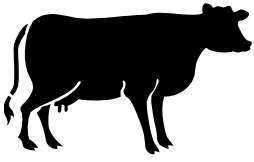

Before The Farm Tour:

Pre-Tour Learning: You and the adult chaperones may want to visit our website www.willowbendfarms.com to see our short farm and family video clips. You will find a selection of videos on our home page and at <http://willowbendfarms.com/farm-tours>. The first video is "Willow Bend Farm". This video is not specifically made for children but gives a great overview of our farm. "How to Feed a Calf" and "Farm It Maybe" videos each star New York Dairy Farm kids on their respective families' New York dairy farms. The "Life on a Dairy Farm" is a more detailed video about dairy farming in New York and features another dairy farm in the Finger Lakes Area.

Groups & Times: We offer group tours for groups of 10 or more. Traditionally, we divide the tour into three rotating stations and provide a tour that lasts at least 1 ½-2 hours long. Tours also have an option to not only tour our working dairy farm but also The Milk Pail (<http://willowbendfarms.com/the-milk-pail/>) However, we can customize the tour specifically to fit your tour group: to work in many different ways, for different durations and covering different types of content. Just let us know what you have in mind and together we can make a plan.

Restroom Facilities: One basic bathroom is located in the milk center.

Buses: Buses will have plenty of space to park on the farm.

Nametags: These are optional, but if the participants arrive wearing nametags, they will truly help facilitate more interaction and discussion with the students.

Clothing: Please have everyone dress appropriately for visiting a farm and for the weather of the day. The tour will be both outside in the weather (and sometimes mud!) and in unheated barns.
